

Utility Buckets

Utility Bucket - "Slip on the forks" accessory buckets or Universal Fit buckets could be used with any design or model of extendable reach forklift. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach component, another new or used universal fit bucket could be located as an alternative. Regular universal lift truck buckets connect to blades which are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Larger fork pockets can be prearranged through an account executive upon request.

For the reason that universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machine and are less at risk to destruction. These buckets are also 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads such as broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach forklifts. They are made to allow positioning of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces stability, resistance to wear and tear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are enhanced by scuff bars along the base of the unit that protect it from scrapes.

Quick-Tach lift buckets could in several circumstances substitute the forks and carriage of a forklift, that may weigh anywhere between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. These buckets when set up can free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both larger and heavier supplies. The Quick-Tach can dump materials more or less 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are fabricated in a custom fashion in order to meet the specs of certain makes and models of lifts.
