Blade extensions come in lengths varying from forty eight to one hundred twenty inches. Triangular or rounded attachments are one more variety utilized when transporting rolled material in order to make sure it does not roll off of the standard flat blades.

Examples of lifting attachments consist of pivoting and telescoping crane or boom attachments. They can come in quite a few various styles and are usually used for transferring poles, metal bars, lumber and various types of bulky objects. Additional accessories such as different kinds of hook plates and hooks are obtainable in order to pick up things with a chain or sling. Magnetic lifters and slab lifters are other stuff which could be used with hook accessories. Slab lifters are specialized accessories that are utilized for lifting various materials which are delivered in a sheet or slab format. Rug rams or carpet poles are other lifting tools which attach to your forklift to be able to make transporting rolls of carpet easier. The accessory connects onto the forklift's blades and has a pole that goes through the middle of the carpet roll.

There are several other types of forklift attachments which can be used for facility maintenance like for instance snow blades. These blades connect to front end loaders and can transport materials such as soil, snow and dirt. Other popular cleanup attachments comprise standard sweepers and magnetic sweepers. Standard sweepers consist of a broom which the lift truck blades hook onto for sweeping large spaces like factory floors, parking lots and warehouse. The magnetic sweeper is the same except that it has a magnetic plate instead of bristles. The magnetic sweeper is utilized in places where there is lots of metal debris such as on shop floors for instance. Sweepers have widths as much as sixty inches and this surface area makes clean up effortless and quick.

Material spreaders are other accessories utilized on lift trucks. These spreaders are handy for a variety of applications like spreading rock salt, pellets, fertilizers, insecticides, seed and ice melt.

Work platforms are another optional lifting accessory which lots of companies use on a daily basis. The platforms range in size from 36" x 36" to up to 60" x 60". There are a few models available that are capable of folding up and storing into a smaller space. Work platforms are designed to raise employees up to an overhead location utilizing the forklift. Larger platform models have additional space for staff to be able to carry tools and other essential stuff meant for the task. Normally work platforms are constructed of steel or ploy material.
